

# **Cooking Corner Sugar Cookies**

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1. **2** 3/4 cups flour
- 2. 1 tsp baking soda
- 3. **1/2** tsp salt
- 4. 11/4 cup margarine
- 5. 2 cups white sugar
- 6. 2 eggs
- 7. 2 tsp vanilla extract
- 8. 1/4 cup sugar (decoration)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Pre heat oven to 350 degree.
- 2. In medium bowl, stir flour, baking soda and salt together. Set aside
- 3. In large bowl, cream together margarine, 2 cups sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in the eggs on at a time, then the vanilla. Gradually stir in the dry ingredients until just blended. Roll dough into walnut sized balls and toll the balls in remaining 1/4 cup sugar.
- 4. Place cookies 2 inches apart onto ungreased cookie sheet and flatten slightly
- 5. Bake 8-10minutes in oven, until lightly browned edges
- 6. Enjoy when cooled!
